**RE: Glucose Supply**

Dear SoonerCare Member,

This letter is to let you know about changes to your diabetic supply services. If you are currently getting your diabetic supplies from a contracted pharmacy, there will be no change for you.

If you are getting your diabetic supplies from a mail-order company or Durable Medical Equipment (DME) supplier, you will need to transition to getting your supplies from your pharmacy by June 1, 2015. After June 1, only contracted pharmacies will be able to give you these supplies.

Starting April 1, 2015, you may contact your local pharmacy and ask them to get the needed prescription from your doctor. Mail-order companies or DME suppliers will not be allowed to bill for diabetic supplies after June 1, 2015.

SoonerCare will pay for One Touch, Precision and FreeStyle strips and meters. Your doctor and pharmacy will help you get a new meter and strips. Lancets, syringes and other supplies will be available from the pharmacy as well. There is no copay for these supplies for SoonerCare members and they will not count against your monthly prescription limit.
