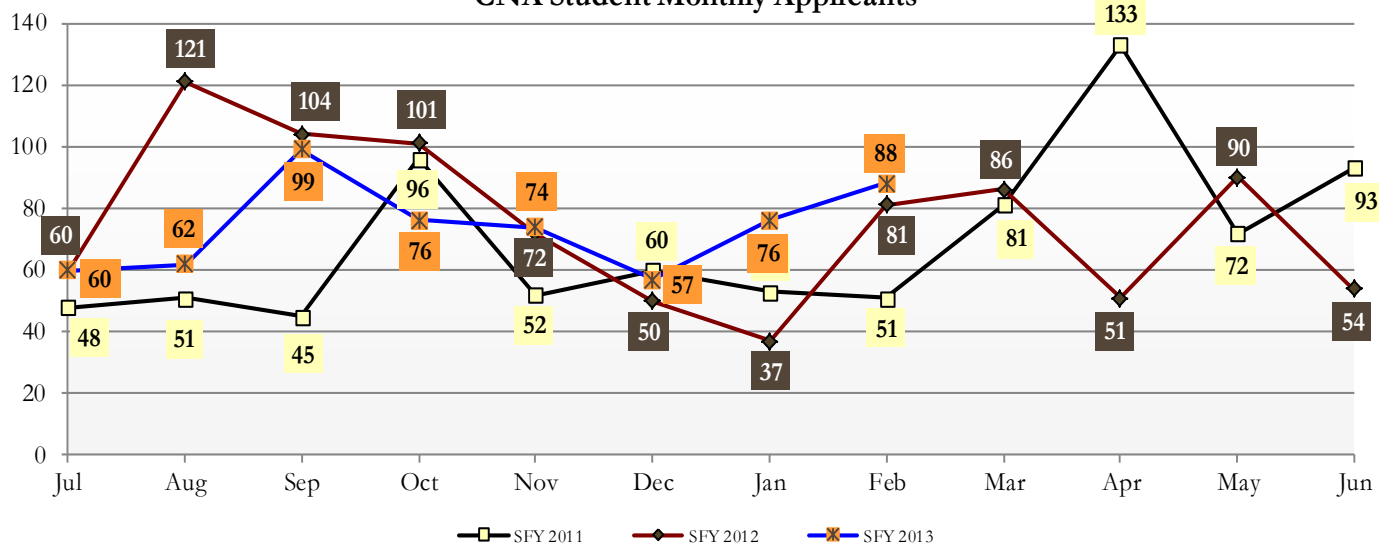
A Certified Nurse Aide (CNA) is an individual who provides nursing or nursing-related service to residents in a long-term care facility. OHCA recognizes the significant role of a CNA. The CNA training program has offered free nurse aide training to qualified applicants since 2005. Two of the continued goals of this program are to improve the quality of life for residents in LTC facilities and to decrease staff turn-over rate. Prospective students must sign an agreement with OHCA that states they will work in a SoonerCare LTC facility for 12 out 24 months after they receive their certification. CNA Student Monthly Applicants

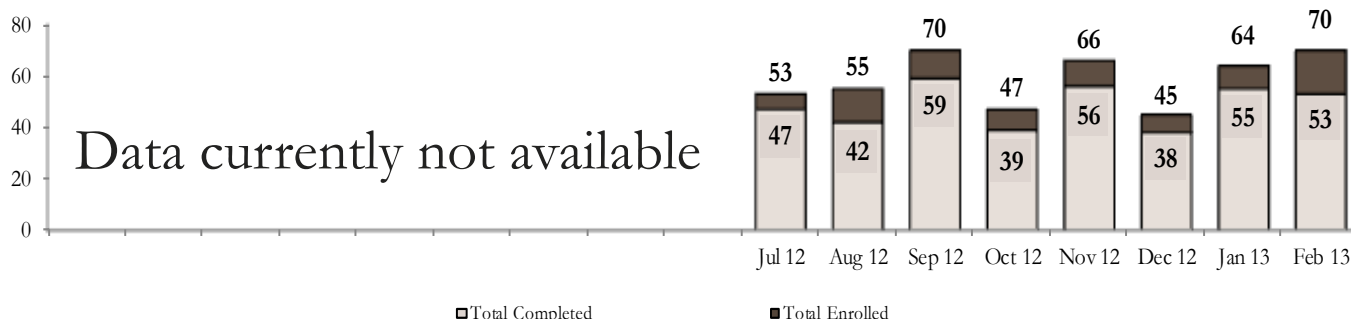


Total Students Enrolled Since Inception 2005	4,845
